- a. **Application 2011-493**, Application for variance in the size and dimensions of an accessory building from Section IV.A.3.a i & ii of the Town of Burlington Regulations to allow garage expansion on property known as 27 Partridge Lane submitted by Matthew Cassina for the reason being the topography and wetness of the property on which the existing structure is at the driest point of the property and with the stipulation that the existing open structure may not be enclosed or further expanded.
